



Congratulations to Donald Viviani recently promoted to Acting DPW Superintendent. Don has resided in Bogota for fifty-five years, served as a volunteer firefighter for thirty-eight years and a member of the DPW for fifteen years. The Mayor and Council look forward to a strong working relationship with Don and his entire team.

The white goods described below will be collected at curbside on the last Friday of each month from January through September 30:

The items are refrigerators and freezers with doors removed, stoves, clothes washers, clothes dryers, dishwashers, air conditioners, hot water heaters, radiators, metal storm doors, metal file cabinets, metal fencing(rolled and tied), metal sofa beds (upholstery tied and placed with trash), auto tire rims, metal auto parts (doors, bumpers), metal bed springs (not fabric covered). Oil tanks require separate permits.

Auto batteries must be taken to the DPW Recycling Center.

For trash/debris removal a DPW truck is available for weekend rentals at \$90 a day for a 3 yard truck and \$200 for a 20 yard truck.

Yard waste: branches should be twined into small bundles; grass, leaves and other yard and garden waste should be placed into biodegradable bags (not plastic)--pickup is either Monday or Tuesday. Leaves are to be bagged for 9 months of the year, with the exception of October, November and December, when they are to be swept into the street for collection.

Special Notice

Effective October 1, 2005 Bogota will institute a once a week garbage pick up schedule. If your normally scheduled pick up was Monday and Thursday your pick up will be Thursday. If your normally scheduled pick up was Tuesday and Friday your pick up will be Tuesday. For weeks where holidays occur please refer to the calendar in the Bogota Quarterly delivered to your home or to the Borough Website, 'Bogotaonline. Org.', where the Bogota Quarterly is also posted.

The Mayor and Council have taken this action in response to rising cost of gasoline and diesel fuel and to continue to maintain a record of low taxes and cost reduction for the Citizens. The proposed change is expected to last through the winter months, October through March only, and we expect to return to twice-weekly pickups in April when the weather turns warm and garbage normally increases in volume.

The recycling schedule remains as is and we will continue to pick up leaves at the curb, as in the past, even as many other towns are requiring leaves to be bagged. Leaves are to be placed loose at the curb for collection. It is very important that leaves not be placed within ten feet of street storm drains.

Please remember all other items for pick up should be placed on the curb. Please, no garbage cans or recyclables, other than leaves are to be placed in the gutter.

Notices on Trees, Poles, Prohibited
 Borough Ordinance 3-22.1 prohibits the posting or attaching by any means any sign, notice, placard or advertisement on public property, such as Borough owned trees or utility poles etc. This ordinance makes it illegal for anyone to post any sign, such as garage sale or other signs regardless of the manner by which the sign is attached to the tree or pole. Persons found to have violated this ordinance may be issued a summons and are subject to a fine and other penalties if convicted in Municipal Court.

Household Waste Collections
 The Bergen County Utilities Authority will sponsor six hazardous household waste collection events between April and October from 9 am. to 3 PM. There will be three collections at Bergen Community College, 400 Paramus Road on April 10, June 12 and October 2. There will be a collection in Moonachie at the authority's headquarters on July 16, and there will be two collections in Mahwah at the B. C. Did You Know?
 The Bogota Water company had a stand pipe "located about 2/3 the way up Elmwood Ave from West Shore Ave. This appears, on the map, to have been a tank about 80 feet in diameter of unknown height. It was probably similar to water tanks on large factories. The purpose was to provide customers with continuous water pressure even with a water supply pump, probably steam, that was only running intermittently.
