### Did You Know?

A close look at our freight shed reveals several features that would have been common at this time (early 1940's). The main building door is at railroad car level and very close to the tracks for ease of freight movement. It has a ramp to a platform at motor truck level height so goods could be easily loaded onto the truck. The telegraph poles, once an essential part of railroad communications, are now devoid of wire as the telephone has replaced the telegraph.
